Position Title: Lidz on Kidz Information/Display Booth Volunteer

Position Description:

The mandate of the Lidz on Kidz program is to generate awareness on the key messages of brain injury and prevention to the general public. This program takes education on prevention, proper helmet fitting and the function of the brain to local schools and minor sport leagues. Lidz on Kidz also provide helmet fitting clinics, and attend community events and this is where this volunteer is needed.

1. Assist at community events such as skateboard mobile parks, minor hockey camps, bike rodeos within the schools and community.
2. Assist with the set-up and take-down of display booths and helmet fitting clinics
3. Assist with teaching proper helmet fitting
4. Provide information about Lidz on Kidz and the Brain Injury Association of Waterloo-Wellington

Skills needed:

- Friendly and outgoing personality
- Must like working with children and youth
- Some knowledge on the brain, concussion and properly fitting helmets
- Ability to assist on weekends and during the school day but this can be accommodating for your individual weekly schedule

Benefits to the Volunteer:

You will be able to utilize your public relations skills and learn about concussion, brain basics and properly fitting helmets for different sporting activities.

Reporting to:

The Information/Booth assistant will directly report to the Lidz on Kidz Educational Coordinator although it is required to send your volunteer hours into the office via email once a month.

Training: Will be provided with an orientation to the BIAWW and the Lidz on Kidz Coordinator and hands-on-training will be provided. Volunteers will have to submit a Police Records Check which BIAWW will pay for if the PRC is clear.

Minimum Age: 18

Car Required: No car is required although the volunteer must find their own transportation to the schools and other community events.

Time Commitment Required: 8 month commitment is desired with the ability to be flexible with time as displays and school presentations do occur on weekends and school days.
